# SCOOTERS AND BIKES

It has been really great to see so many of our children using scooters and bikes to come to school. Children are <u>not</u> allowed to ride their scooters and bikes on the playgrounds for safety reasons.

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# CORONAVIRUS AND SCHOOL

If your child has any symptoms of coronavirus such as:

- a high temperature
- a new continuous cough (coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours)
- A loss or change to sense of smell or taste (this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal)

Get a test to check if they have coronavirus as soon as possible.

Stay at home and do not have visitors until you get the test result – only leave your home to have a test.

Anyone you live with, and anyone in your support bubble, must also stay at home until you get the result.

The school will let families know if a child or member of staff tests positive.

Please remember to follow Government and Public Health advice. When dropping off or picking up your child we would appreciate it if you could remember to social distance to help ensure we keep our community as safe as possible. Thank you.
