What objects can you find that have the **air** sound?

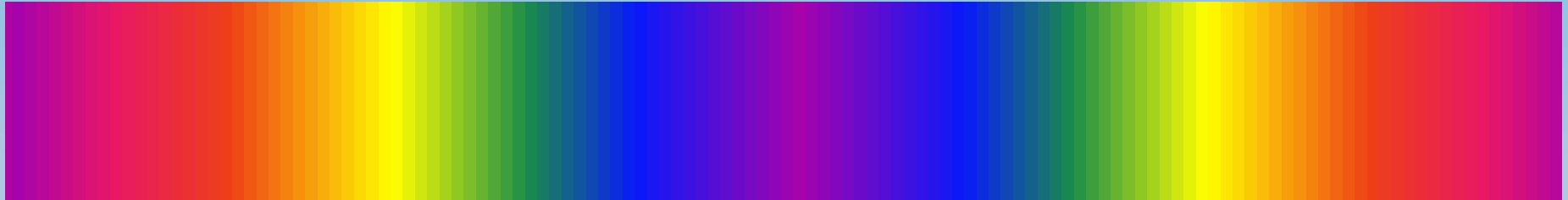
Can you find any **air** words in your books?

Today we are going to recapping at the trigraph air

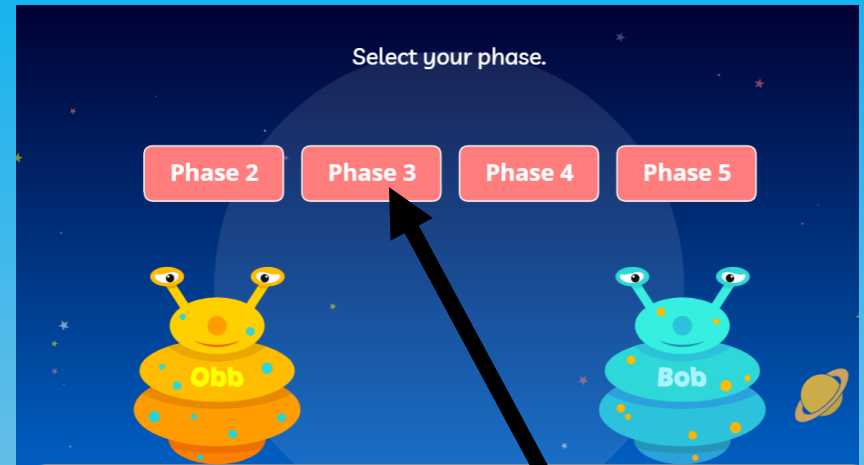

How many times can you write the 'air' sound in 1 minute?

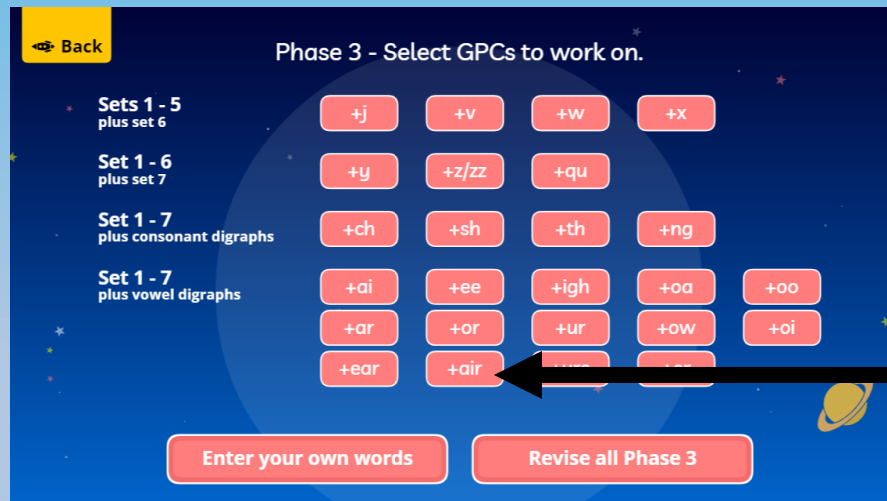
When you are ready, click once to start the 1 minute timer!



To revise **air** click on Phase 3, then 'air'
