This year we're teaming up with Classfundraising.co.uk, a PTA approved company that raises funds for schools by creating gifts from your child's artwork. We're going for an early bird booking so look out for the templates in your child's book bag. **Please return your completed designs to your class teacher by Friday 20**th **Oct**. FOSW send the completed templates to Classfundraising, who print a sample card of every design and return to school, so parents can see their child's design before they order.

As the Autumn days are drawing in, it's a good time to have a sort-out of all your summer clothes! Look out for a Yellow Funds4Schools Bag coming home in your child's book bag before half-term. This is a great way to fundraise for school whilst clearing out your second-hand clothing.
