### GROWING SUCCESS ROOTED IN FAITH

Dear Parents and Carers,

Your child may be entitled to extra government funding to support their learning.

The government gives schools £1345 for every child who applies and qualifies for Free School Meals. Your child does not have to have the free meal, they can still have packed lunch if they prefer. This funding is called 'Pupil Premium'. The school uses this money to provide extra support with learning in the classroom, access to extra-curricular opportunities and emotional support (where necessary). As school budgets are even tighter than ever, we really need those who are eligible to apply for this crucial funding.

If your child is in reception, year 1 and 2, you still need to apply for the funding even though your child is already provided with a free school meal.

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you receive any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
