

## St. Wilfrid's CofE Primary School

### Swimming data 2017-2018:

At St. Wilfrid's, all children have the opportunity to take part in swimming lessons for a 12 week period whilst they are in year four. They are assessed in a range of areas including the distance they are able to swim unaided, their awareness of safety within the pool, self-rescue, their ability to push and glide to start swimming and the range of strokes they are able to carry out.

At the end of Year Six, the ability of the children is then reviewed. Any children who have not met the required standard are then given the opportunity to take part in further sessions.

Below shows the ability of the current year six cohort who will leave St. Wilfrid's at the end of the 2017-2018 academic year.

<b>National curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety</b>	<b>Percentage of children meeting requirements</b>
Children can swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25m	74.6%
Children can use a range of strokes effectively	69.5%
Children can perform self-rescue in different water-based situations	86.4%

The percentages relate to the 59 children we currently have in year six.

Any children needing further lessons will be offered these in the second part of the summer term.
